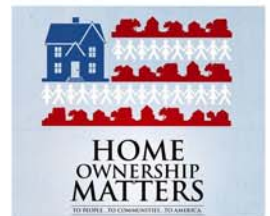

The Remodeling for Access and Mobility Project provides low-income home owners with improved access to their homes. Community volunteers construct wheel chair ramps or make other necessary exterior modifications.
